Dr. Chatman talked about the upcoming Georgia Milestone Test. He talked about the testing window, what parents could do to help their children be prepared for the test, what grade levels would be taking the Georgia Milestones, etc. He talked about wanting to do something for the students, like providing them with breakfast. At the end of this talk Dr. Chatman asked if there were any questions. Parents said no. They did not have any questions about what Dr. Chatman had discussed with them concerning the Ga. Milestone but wanted to ask about Gym Classes. Mrs. Abney asked, "Why was the gym so overcrowded sometimes". Dr. Chatman said that when connections teachers are absent and their substitute teacher has not shown up. The rest of the connection teachers have to divide the classes up so other PE teachers that are in the gym are there with their classes so overcrowding is going to happen. Dr. Chatman also talked about our Friday Meet and Greet for our students. Friday Meet and Greet.
