
The Community

Joseph R. Lamar



1857-1916

Justice Lamar lived in Augusta for a number of years as a boy. He served on the U.S. Supreme court from 1911-1916. His final rest-

ing place is in Summerville Cemetery, Augusta, GA.

John Milledge



1757-1818

served as Governor of Georgia from 1802-1806. He was instrumental in establishing the University of Georgia. In 1818, he died

at his plantation home in Augusta, GA. and was buried in the Summerville Cemetery.
